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Evgenia Sendova is Associate Professor at IMI-BAS, member of the Education in Mathematics and Informatics Department with PhD in informatics. Her interest in education was harnessed in the frames of the Research Group on Education (1979-1989), an educational experiment of BAS and the Ministry of Education where she was involved in creating a new curriculum, educating teachers and students in guided discovery style, and editing journals for teachers. Since 1997 she has been involved as a tutor in the annual Research Science Institute, a summer program for gifted high school students in mathematics and science, organized by the Center of Excellence in Education jointly with MIT, USA. She coordinated the Bulgarian collaboration with the American educational center Best Practices in Education for developing strategies and resources for mathematics education in the secondary school. E. Sendova is author and co-author of more than 120 articles in scientific journals, 5 books and more than 20 textbooks. She has got the IFIP Outstanding Services Award (1991), Siemens certificate for working with young talents in mathematics and science (2003), Golden Feather award of the Union of the Bulgarian Teachers (2011). She has been involved in the recent years in 10 European projects dealing with IBL, and was coordinator for IMI-BAS of Scientix.
